

**Statement of Representation Procedure and Availability of Documents –
Rutland Local Plan 2021-2041**

**Regulation 19: Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England)
Regulations 2012 (as amended)**

Rutland County Council has prepared the Pre-submission Local Plan (Regulation 19) ahead of submission to the Planning Inspectorate and examination on behalf of the Secretary of State. The Local Plan sets out the broad spatial planning and policy framework for Rutland up to 2041. The Local Plan includes our vision and ambitions for the future of Rutland with a vision, strategic objectives, policies and site allocations to meet growth targets. It identifies the level and type of development over the plan period together with the locations where it should go.

Consultation Period

Representations are invited during the consultation period which begins at **9am on Monday 21st October 2024 and closes at 4pm on Monday 2nd December**. The consultation will run the statutory minimum period of six weeks.
